Why St Wilfrid?

The Parish has been named St Wilfrid after the earliest Christian foundation in Widnes, when a chapel in his honour was built in the year 1180.

St Wilfrid lived from 633-710 and his Feast Day is on 12th October.

The Parish of St Wilfrid is served by four churches, St Michael's, St Basil's, St Bede's and St John Fisher.

Four priests, Fr Matthew Nunes (Dean of Widnes), Fr Joseph Bibby, Fr Malcolm Prince, and retired Bishop John Rawsthorne now work together as a team across the parish.
