

CVC jigsaws

Ready to cut out, match and learn.

Using CVC jigsaws are a fun way for your child to learn to read and represent an image with it's written form.

Encourage your child to press the blue sound buttons as they pronounce each sound. If you are unsure of the correct pronunciation, refer to the *Phonics Cards PDF* on Reception class page for guidance.

Begin by working on just one CVC jigsaw to start. Once your child is secure with that CVC then progress to mixing up two or three jigsaws.

Another fun activity may be to hide parts of the CVC jigsaws around your home/garden. Give your child clues to help them find them.

To challenge your child further, encourage them to write some of the CVC words down or maybe even write a story using the words they have just learnt.
