Mission Statement

At St. Bede's Catholic Infant School it is the mission of the whole school community to nurture a safe, supportive environment in which the individual has the opportunity to develop intellectually, spiritually and emotionally in an atmosphere of trust and mutual respect.

Rationale

At St. Bede's Catholic Infant School, we believe wearing a school uniform enables children to thrive and succeed in an environment that promotes equality and inclusivity for all. Our school uniform is comfortable and meets the rigours and demands of daily activities that children participate in. With affordability at the forefront of our uniform decisions, branded uniforms (or school logos) are completely optional.

Purposes

Our school uniform policy is based on:

- promoting inclusivity and equality;
- practicality (with health and safety in mind);
- affordability;
- a sense of belonging to the St. Bede's community



Jewellery

Children are allowed to wear a watch but this must be removed before P.E. Small stud earrings are allowed if covered by tape before arrival at school. Earrings should not be worn on P.E days.

Footwear

Children are encouraged to wear smart, black school shoes. We discourage black trainers or shoes that are branded, have logos or novelty attachments / adornments.

Book bags

All children are required to bring a book to school. Children should not bring rucksacks; a book bag is sufficient. We cannot accommodate large bags as each child has a small tray to store their belongings.

School Uniform

Grey trousers

Grey skirt or pinafore

White shirt or polo shirt

Black, grey or green tights

Grey or white socks

Black footwear (see footwear section above)



P.E. Kit

White T-Shirt or polo shirt

Black shorts, tracksuit bottoms or leggings

Black pumps

Trainers (for outdoor sessions)

Your child should come into school wearing their PE kit on their designated PE days.

All footwear and clothing must be clearly marked with your child's name.
